KEY TAKEAWAYS FROM LEIDEN

- Develop your network and establish links with relevant institutes, organizations and international networks (e.g. CBD-CHM)
- Collaborate with other GBIF nodes
- Build trust, be patient, never give up
- Make your node indispensable, communicate GBIF values
- GBIF is good value for money
- Apply for projects inside and outside of the GBIF community
- Be flexible, open to new ideas and innovative
- Diversify funding sources
- Don't stay silent, ask!

Make good contacts with other institutes and organizations

Make your node relevant and 'incontournable'

Apply for projects inside the GBIF community and outside

Make links between the node and the CBD Clearing House Mechanism

3 Tips when talking about money with officials:

- Be patient
- Be persistent
- Be flexible

Never ever give up!

Better coordination of European nodes would create a stronger consortium to apply for European funding

Use bilateral cooperation between governments on science or environment for node/GBIF activities

GBIF is good value for money!

Build trust for success

Aim for both top-down and bottom-up approaches

Combine project based and institutional funding

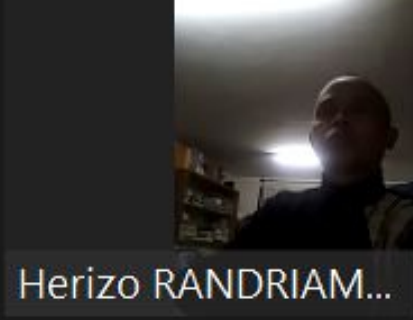
Ask for anything rather than stay silent!
